

PROCEEDINGS OF THE RESEARCH & EXTENSION INTERFACE MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER ON DT. 19.12.2017 OF KRISHI VIGYAN KENDRA, DEOGARH

The research & extension interface meeting for the month of December, 2017 was held at 4.30 PM on dt. 19.12.2017 in the Chamber of Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Deogarh under the Chairmanship of Sri Dwarikanath Pradhan, District Agriculture Officer, Deogarh.

After a brief introductory remark about the meeting of research and extension interface by Senior Scientist & Head, KVK the following discussions have been made department wise as per the instruction of the Chairman.

1) Department of Agriculture

Under Chief Minister package 75% subsidy plant protection chemicals around 293.75 ltrs. already supplied to the BPH affected farmers for pest management programme in the district and also mini kit programme like greengram-400 nos., sesamum-150 nos. already supplied and 100 nos. groundnut minikit yetis yet to be supplied in irrigated area to the affected farmers. Under NFSM programme 400 ha of greengram programme has been conducted. Under rice-fallow area programme 500 nos. of minikit of groundnut has been distributed to farmers of the district. In the month of January, 2018 3 nos. of Krushak Sampark mela will be organised in the three blocks of the district.

2) Department of Horticulture

Assistant Director of Horticulture, Deogarh has been summarised that under Chief Minister package for moisture stress area 200 nos. of minikit of vegetable. Under state plan 17 q of onion seed and 160 q. of potato seed has been distributed to the farmers of the district.

3) Veterinary Department

Veterinary Department, Deogarh completed the following programmes in the month of December, 2017.

- i) Vaccination of Livestock-38350 nos.
- ii) Artificial Insemination - 918 cattle.
- iii) Animal health camp conducted – 41 nos.
- iv) Total treatment – 4533 nos.
- v) Nos. of castration – 399 nos.

4) Fishery Department

District Fisheries Officer briefing the achievement and action plan of fishery department.

Achievement of December 2017:

1. Subsidy of own source development tank under RKVY was released amounting Rs.3.15 lakhs area 1.26 ha.

2. Pending subsidy of FFDA scheme under Bank Finance has been released amounting Rs.0.63 lakhs area 0.80 ha.
3. Financial assistance to WSHG has been made 20 nos. of WSHG Rs.1.00 lakhs @ Rs.5000/- SHG.
4. New own source developed tank 4 nos. has been visited by Dy. Director Fisheries (AZ) Angul, District Fishery Officer, Deogarh and AFO, Barkote (own source committee member).
5. Under newly launched scheme MPY(Mo Pokhari Yojana), 10 nos. of application has been received on offline (Area 4.00 ha.)
6. One application received for establishment to Fish Seed Hatchery Complex to be invested Rs.25.00 lakhs (40% subsidy)

Proposed Action Plan for January 2018:

1. Financial assistance to 8 nos. of WSHG will be made.
2. Subsidy of development tanks under bank finance & own source of Blue Revolution/RKVY will be released.
3. Exposure visit to CIFRI, Kolkata will be made under ATMA (6 nos. fish farmer).
4. Post stocking awareness camp at Gohira medium project will be organised.

Soil Conservation Department

In 2017-18 under Livelihood & Production System Micro Enterprises programme 172 ha of vegetable cultivation, 447 ha of Pulse (Horsegram, Greengram and Blackgram) and 250 ha. of Oilseed (Groundnut and Sunflower) has been conducted. Under Rainfed Agriculture Development Programme(RAD) 4 nos. of goat supplied to 15 beneficiaries and insurance of the goats has been done. Under Chief Minister package for drought affected area minikit of potato & onion supplied to affected beneficiaries.

NGO, CSDR, Madhyapur

Under IRRI programme 1 q greengram demonstration has been taken up in Podapada village in Reamal Block. 100 acre seed village programme of pulse crop supported by NABARD has been initiated. 5 nos. of training programme supported by NABARD is going on.

Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Deogarh

Senior Scientist & Head briefed the activities of KVK like 6 nos. of farmers and farm women training has been conducted under Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline during this month. Doubling Farmers' Income by Technological Interventions of KVK is going on. In cluster demonstration of pulses (Pigeonpea) in total 20 ha area in villages like Kadopada, Majhipalli and Bangalimunda and the crop is in pod initiation stage in rabi season Greengram sowing is continuing in 20 ha area in Kadopada and Kundapitha village. In cluster demonstration of oil seed (Sesamum) harvesting is completed in the villages like Prabhasuni & Kadopada. In rabi oilseed farmer and field selection is completed and seed will be distributed to farmers by this month for 20 ha area in Kailash, Nuabhuin

and Suguda village. Action plan for the month of January 2018 proposed as 3 nos. farmers and farm women training of Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline will be conducted. OFT and FLD programmes are going on as per action plan. Senior Scientist & Head also requested all the line departments to make convergence of different schemes of their departments in KVK module villages which for benefit of the farmer community of the district. Senior Scientist & Head requested to District Agriculture Officer, Deogarh to support for better implementation of seed production programme in the district. One mushroom entrepreneur participated in the programme and requested all line departments to get subsidy or project proposal for production of mushroom only but Asst. Director of Horticulture briefed that there is no project or assistance for mushroom production but there is assistance for mushroom spawn production.

The Chairman thanked all the members & urged cooperation from all line departments for benefit of farming community of the district.
