

PROCEEDINGS OF THE RESEARCH - EXTENSION INTERFACE LINKAGE FOR THE MONTH OF JULY ON DT. 17.07.2018

The monthly R-E linkage meeting was held on dt.17.07.2018, 10.30AM in the chamber of Senior Scientist and Head, KVK, Deogarh. Discussion was held on the proceeding of the last R-E meeting and action taken on it. Following discussions were made in the meeting.

1. The Senior Scientist and Head, KVK, Deogarh gave a brief introduction regarding the activities conducted by KVK. He discussed on his vision to purpose the farmers status through introduction of new technologies in agri and allied sector.
2. Deputy Director of Agriculture suggested to select potential villages along river bank and to create farmers interest group for maximum utilization of irrigated area. Crops like onion, watermelon , pumpkin and sweet potato may be taken up in those areas.
3. DDM, NABARD suggested to invite all the banks including SBI to attend the R-E linkage meeting. The LDM is requested to provide the email id of all banks of Deogarh district to KVK in this regard.
4. Senior Scientist and Head, KVK, Deogarh suggested to invite successful agri-entrepreneurs in the meeting and agri entrepreneurs will be sponsored from each deptt. on rotational basis.
5. All line department officers gave their consent to open a new whats app group of R-E meeting.
6. It was decided to upload new technologies adopted by farmers in Youtube.
7. All agreed to promote organic farming in an integrated approach in village Kirtanpalli of Reamal block and vermicomposting should be encouraged among the farmers. PD ATMA is requested to assist KVK to popularize the technology in Swatchh Bharat village.
8. Steps will be taken to taste new varieties of tomato from ICAR-IIHR, Bangalore along with mulching and trailing techniques by KVK. The horticulture deptt. is asked to popularize such technology in Deogarh district.
9. A booklet will be published on success stories of 100 farmers. All line deptt. officers to provide stories along with photographs to KVK. ATMA is requested to sponsor it.
10. DDM, NABARD suggested all line departments to present their achievements and success stories every month.
11. Seed hub (pulses) of KVK and FPO programme of NABARD should work in a collaborative approach for successful implementation of programme.
12. AFO proposed following action plan for the month of August,2018;
 - Fish seed production in private sector hatchery of Sri Promod Kumar Pradhan will be initiated during the month.

- All identified G.P. tanks will be tagged with WSHG on long term leased basis through PR department.
 - Subsidy to be released in favour of 9 nos. of beneficiaries under MPY.
 - Fry rearing and distribution to be taken of at govt. fish farm, Barkote.
13. The district nodal officer of Deptt. of AH approached treatment of 4802 animals, castration of 455 animals, artificial insemination of 1113 nos. of cows, 47 nos. of deworming camps and vaccination of 47521 animals in the month of July.
14. DDM, NABARD suggested that in R-Seti agro-based trainings, resource person from KVK, Line Deptts. and local successful entrepreneurs should invited in priority basis.
15. The secretary of CSDR(NGO) requested for all kinds of support from all line deptts. officers to initiate the work on livelihood mission in their target village.
16. The Pre-PLP meeting of the year was discussed by the DDM, NABARD. He suggested that govt's objective for doubling of farmers income should be kept in mind before implementing any programme.
