

## **PROCEEDINGS OF THE RESEARCH & EXTENSION INTERFACE MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE ON DT. 20.06.2017 OF KRISHI VIGYAN KENDRA, DEOGARH**

The research & extension interface meeting for the month of June, 2017 was held at 4.00 PM on 20.06.2017 in the Chamber of Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Deogarh under the Chairmanship of Sri Bijaya Kumar Mohapatra, Deputy Director Agriculture-cum-PD ATMA, Deogarh.

After a brief introductory remark about the meeting of research and extension interface by Senior Scientist & Head, KVK the following discussions have been made department wise as per the instruction of the Chairman.

### **1) Department of Agriculture**

DDA Deogarh briefed that kharif paddy seeds supplied through DBT system is 2705 q against the target of 3880 q through 29 PACS and one private input dealer in the District. Under seed production programme during this kharif, department will conduct 144 ha of Paddy var. Pooja, Swarna, 1001, Pratikshya & Naveen. Under demonstration programme for kharif 2017 line transplanting of 300 ha @ 100 ha per block, DSR (Direct seeded Rice)- 500 ha (200 ha Barkote, 200 ha Reamal, 100 ha Tileibani) under NFSM (Rice). Under NFSM (Pulse) in minikit Programme Greengram (var IPM-2-14) 250 minikits @ 4 kg/kit, Blackgram (var. IPU-02-43) 150 minikit @ 4 kg/kit will distribute to farmers. Minikit of sesamum (var. RT-346) 200 kit @ 1 kg/kit will be provided to farmer under NMOOP. In state plan scheme in green manuring cum seed production programme 25 q Dhanicha seed supplied for 100 ha area (Barkote 35 ha, Reamal 35 ha and Tileibani 30 ha). Line transplanting programme will be taken up in 400 ha. area. In soil health card scheme soil sample collection target is 5050 nos. In PMFBY for kharif 2017 paddy crops National insurance company will cover Deogarh district. Premium @ 2% i.e. Rs.1200/- per ha and the cut off date is 31<sup>st</sup> July 2017. District level awareness programme completed in 1<sup>st</sup> week of June 2017. Block level awareness programme is going on dt. 19.06.17, 20.06.17 & 21.06.17 in Barkote, Reamal & Tileibani block respectively. Target for loanee farmer is 13470 Nos., target for non-loanee farmer 1840 Nos. and total area to be insured is 12000 ha. Diploma in Agriculture Extension Service for input dealers (DAESI) programme will be started from 1<sup>st</sup> week of July 2017. 40 nos. of input dealers having minimum qualification HSC pass from three blocks will take part in the programme and the participant contribution of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) for the programme. Certificate will be provided by MANAGE, Hyderabad to participating input dealers after successful completion of 48 weeks course programme. In ITDA programme 92 nos. Forest Right Act (FRA) beneficiaries from 4 villages of Palkuder & Kendejhuri GP have been taken up to demonstrate 46.5 acre hybrid maize (variety PAC -751). Critical inputs like seed, fertilisers and herbicides has been provided to beneficiaries. 1<sup>st</sup> level training programme also completed.

### **2) Department of Horticulture**

Assistant Horticulture Officer, Deogarh has been summarised that department will take up 62 ha mango plantation under NHM, 75 ha mango plantation in convergence with MGNREGA and NHM, 75 ha mango plantation purely under MGNREGA. 5 ha Banana plantation under NHM will be taken up. In ITDA

programme Kharif tomato programme has been taken up in KalchipadaDihi and Beluam villages of Sodo gram panchayat.

### **3) Veterinary Department**

Veterinary Department, Deogarh completed the following programmes in the month of May, 2017.

- i) Vaccination of Livestock–14,100 nos.
- ii) Organization of Awareness and Animal Health Camp in Mobile Veterinary unit (MVU)–32 nos.
- iii) Placement of fund under NMPS of Rs.10400.00 has been disbursed to the 2 beneficiaries for establishment of unit towards 3<sup>rd</sup> phase.
- iv) Placement of fund under genetic upgradation of animals of Rs. 10,000.00 to 3 beneficiaries towards 3<sup>rd</sup> phase.
- v) Insurance of animals under NLM-150 nos.

### **4) Fishery Department**

District Fisheries Officer briefing the achievement and action plan of fishery department.

#### Achievement of June 2017

- a. Total 13 nos. (7.40 ha. area) cases sponsored both Bank Finance and own source under RastriyaKrushvi Vikash Yojana (RKVY).
- b. Total 46 nos. (15.26 ha area) cases sponsored both Bank Finance and own source under Blue Revolution.
- c. Pre stocking management of Govt. Fish Farm, Barkote is going on for stocking of 170 lakhs of Spawn.
- d. Details survey of WSHG involved in Fisheries activities was completed.

#### Proposed Action Plan for July 2017

- a) Subsidy under RKVY and Blue Revolution of 3.68 ha. area for the year 2016-17 will be released after visiting of subsidy committee.
- b) Subsidy under blue revolution of 1.50 ha. area for the year 2017-18 will be released after visiting of subsidy committee.
- c) Pre-stocking management of Govt. fish farm, Barkote will be ensured for stocking of spawn.
- d) An awareness camp on mobile service will be organised.
- e) Identification and approval of scholarship to meritorious fishermen children.
- f) Preparation of captive nursery for fingerling stocking of reservoir will be completed within this month.
- g) Supervision of WSHG activities in way of pisciculture, dry fish marketing and ornamental fish culture.

### **Soil Conservation Department**

4 nos. WHS of Rs.15 lakh has been completed during this month. Turfing of 30 projects will be taken up during this month.

## **NGO, CSDR, Madhyapur**

Under IRRI programme 50 ha demonstration will be taken up in Reamal Block. Head to head trial of 2 ha will also be taken up during this kharif.

## **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Deogarh**

Senior Scientist & Head proposed the action plan of KVK Deogarh for the year 2017-18 as 6 nos. of OFT, 11 nos. of FLD, 36 nos. of farmers and farm women training, 6 nos. in-service training, 3 nos. of rural youth training and 3 nos. of Vocational training to be conducted under Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline. Doubling Farmers' Income by Technological Interventions of KVK has also been placed in the meeting and the proposed action plan and module has been approved by the members. Cluster demonstration of pulses (pigeon pea) of 20 ha and oilseed (sesamum) of 20 ha area will be conducted during the kharif-2017.

The Chairman thanked all the members & urged cooperation from all line departments for benefit of farming community of the district.
