

PROCEEDINGS OF THE RESEARCH & EXTENSION INTERFACE MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER ON DT. 22.11.2017 OF KRISHI VIGYAN KENDRA, DEOGARH

The research & extension interface meeting for the month of November, 2017 was held at 1.30 PM on dt. 22.11.2017 in the Chamber of Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Deogarh under the Chairmanship of Sri Khagendranath Jena, Deputy Director Agriculture-cum-PD ATMA, Deogarh.

After a brief introductory remark about the meeting of research and extension interface by Senior Scientist & Head, KVK the following discussions have been made department wise as per the instruction of the Chairman.

1) Department of Agriculture

Under NMOOP scheme 600 Mustard minikits (var. RGN 236) @ 2 kg (Barkote – 250, Reamal-200, Tileibani-150 kits) supplied during this Rabi. In Sesamum crop block demonstration of 100 ha area (Barkote-40, Reamal-40 & Tileibani 20 ha) is to be conducted during Rabi 2017. One farmers training (25 farmers) for 2 days will be organised at Reamal block HQ under NMOOP scheme. Under State plan scheme 3 nos. of Krishaka Sampark Mela @ 1 no. each block will be organised. Field day will be organised in NFSM rice demonstration area during Kharif 2017. 42 nos. POS machine has been already supplied to the fertiliser dealer and another 40 nos. will be supplied during this month. Under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana in Paddy crop cutting by the extension staffs of Agriculture, Statistics and revenue persons already started in all the blocks by capturing the data of crop cutting through Smart phone. Registration and generation of farmers ID for DBT programme is in progress in all blocks. Attack of BPH in paddy crop has been noticed about 200 ha in all the blocks of the district which is under control condition by e-pest surveillance programme under RKVY scheme.

2) Department of Horticulture

Assistant Director of Horticulture, Deogarh has been summarised that under RKVY potato mission 100 q Potato seed, 17 q Onion seed will be supplied during this Rabi 2017-18. Under NHM 5 ha papaya plantation will be conducted.

3) Veterinary Department

Veterinary Department, Deogarh completed the following programmes in the month of November, 2017.

- i) Vaccination of Livestock–37850 nos.
- ii) Artificial Insemination - 1005 cattle.
- iii) Animal health camp conducted – 53 nos.

iv) Total treatment – 3751 nos.

4) Fishery Department

District Fisheries Officer briefing the achievement and action plan of fishery department.

Achievement of November 2017:

1. One time scholarship to 34 nos. of meritorious fishermen children with a total sum of Rs.1,85,000/- has been paid.
2. Subsidy to 3 nos. of beneficiaries under RKVY without Bank Finance/Own source has been transferred to their bank account amounting Rs.4.85 lakhs through RTGS.
3. 600 kg advance fingerling has been stocked in Gohira dam (medium project) from Govt. fish farm, Barkote.
4. Two days training cum awareness camp has been organised at Deogarh in joint collaboration with Watershed, Deogarh. 50 nos. of farmers attended the programme.

Proposed Action Plan for December 2017:

1. 250 kg fingerlings to be supplied to Keonjhar District from Govt. Fish Farm, Barkote.
2. Subsidy will be paid 5 nos. of beneficiaries under RKVY & Blue Revolution without Bank finance.
3. Financial assistance to WSHG involved in pisciculture will be made for 20 nos. of WSHG.
4. Bank finance will be arranged for 40 nos. of Net & Boat to the fishermen under MUJ & Blue revolution.
5. Visit to new tanks by own source subsidy committee for 5 nos. of developed tanks.

Soil Conservation Department

In 2017-18 under Livelihood & Production System Micro Enterprises programme 62 units of Pisciculture, 172 ha of vegetable cultivation, 447 ha of Pulse (Horsegram, Greengram and Blackgram) and 250 ha. of Oilseed (Groundnut and Sunflower) has been approved for Rabi season. Fingerlings stocking completed in 178 water bodies of 3 blocks.

NGO, CSDR, Madhyapur

Under IRRI programme 50 ha demonstration has been taken up in Reamal Block. Head to head trial of 2 ha has also been taken up during this kharif.

Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Deogarh

Senior Scientist & Head briefed the activities of KVK like 6 nos. of farmers and farm women training has been conducted under Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline during this month. Doubling Farmers' Income by

Technological Interventions of KVK is going on. In cluster demonstration of pulses (Pigeonpea) in total 20 ha area in villages like Kadopada, Majhipalli and Bangalimunda and the crop is in vegetative stage. In cluster demonstration of oil seed (Sesamum) seed sowing completed and the crop is in vegetative stage in total 20 ha area in the villages like Prabhasuni & Kadopada. Action plan for the month of November 2017 proposed as 6 nos. farmers and farm women training of Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline will be conducted. OFT and FLD programmes are going on as per action plan. Senior Scientist & Head also requested all the line departments to make convergence of different schemes of their departments in KVK adopted villages which are named as Prime Minister village (Vill-Kailash, GP-Tainsar, Block-Tileibani), Chancellor village (Vill-Kumurapalli, GP-Dholpada, Block- Tileibani), Chief Minister village (Vill-Kalchipadadihi, GP- Sodo, Block- Tileibani), Sansad village (Vill-Singshal, GP- Singshal, Block- Barkote), Vice Chancellor village (Vill-Sadhupalli, GP- Tentelabahal, Block-Reamal) for benefit of the farmer community of the district. AGM, NABARD, Sambalpur also emphasized on convergence of pulse seed production of NABARD and seed hub programme of KVK for better implementation of seed production programme in convergence mode.

The Chairman thanked all the members & urged cooperation from all line departments for benefit of farming community of the district.
