

PROCEEDINGS OF THE RESEARCH & EXTENSION INTERFACE MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER ON DT.20.09.2017 OF KRISHI VIGYAN KENDRA, DEOGARH

The research & extension interface meeting for the month of September, 2017 was held at 4.00 PM on dt.20.09.2017 in the Chamber of Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Deogarh under the Chairmanship of Sri Khagendranath Jena, Deputy Director Agriculture-cum-PD ATMA, Deogarh.

After a brief introductory remark about the meeting of research and extension interface by Senior Scientist & Head, KVK the following discussions have been made department wise as per the instruction of the Chairman.

1) Department of Agriculture

100% crop coverage under paddy of total area of 34500 ha. Non-paddy coverage is 32250 ha against the target 32450 ha. Total no. of soil sample collected 3840 against target 5050 & sample tested is 1076 nos. till date. Under NFSM (rice) – 300 ha under line transplanting, DSR (500 ha) and stress tolerance (300 ha). Only seed component was supplied to the farmers and other inputs will be supplied through DBT system. In RKVY plan E-pest surveillance of kharif 2017 is going on and stem borer, blast and BLB infestation is reported by the AAOs of all block through scouting and sent the message through online. Pesticides and fungicides are available in sale centres to control the pest and disease. 49 machines out of 102 POS machine supplied to dealers including PACS by KRIBHCO. Block demonstration of sesame 100 ha will be conducted during this month under NMOOP scheme after availability of seeds. 600 mini kit of mustard was supplied to farmers for demonstration under NMOOP.

2) Department of Horticulture

Assistant Director of Horticulture, Deogarh has been summarised that department completed diversion of QPM for 40 ha mango plantation under NHM, 75 ha mango plantation in convergence with MGNREGA and NHM, 75 ha mango plantation purely under MGNREGA. 50 ha cashew plantation competed in convergence with MGNREGA. In ITDA programme Kharif tomato is in fruiting stage in Kalchipada Dihi and Beluam villages of Sodo gram panchayat. 40 onion storage and 5 pack house beneficiaries selected to execute the programme

3) Veterinary Department

Veterinary Department, Deogarh completed the following programmes in the month of September, 2017.

- i) Vaccination of Livestock–75600 nos.
- ii) Backyard poultry chick of 45 nos. supplied to each of the 48 BPL farmers.
- iii) Artificial Insemination of 927 cattle.
- iv) Insurance of animals under Risk Management -852 nos.
- v) Animal health camp conducted – 41 nos.
- vi) Serum collection for Anthrax – 100 Nos.

4) Fishery Department

District Fisheries Officer briefing the achievement and action plan of fishery department.

Achievement of September 2017

1. Spawn (fish seed) 170.00 lakhs stocked in Govt. fish farm Barkote.
2. Fry (fish seed) sold to fish famers as on 20.09.2017 = 19.82 lakhs.
3. Revenue receipt as on 20.09.2017 = Rs.3,52,440/- from sale proceed of fry.
4. Own source subsidy committee visited developed tanks area 0.80 ha for release of subsidy.
5. 20 nos. of net & boat proposal sponsored to banks under MUY.
6. 04 nos. of applications for scholarship to meritorious fishermen children collected during the month.

Proposed Action Plan for October 2017

1. Fish seed of Rs.30,000/- to be distributed to 10 nos. of progressive fish famers under ATMA, Deogarh.
2. Subsidy to be released for development tanks of an area 5.18 ha obtaining approval of collector and D.M., Deogarh.
3. One awareness camp to be organised shortly on dt.22/09/2017
4. Survey & identification of G.P tanks feasible for fish culture in the district to be done.
5. Details project report for intensive pisciculture by WSHG/PFCS in G.P tanks/revenue tanks to be submitted to be submitted to Collector & D.M., Deogarh for approval.
6. Watershed water bodies in Deogarh district has been surveyed and finalised for stocking of fish seeds.

Soil Conservation Department

In 2017-18 under Livelihood & Production System Micro Enterprises programme 62 units of Pisciculture, 172 ha of vegetable cultivation, 447 ha of Pulse (Horsegram, Greengram and Blackgram) and 250 ha. of Oilseed (Groundnut and Sunflower) has been approved for Rabi season. 1,88,000 fingerlings has been distributed to fisher group under Production System and Micro Enterprises

NGO, CSDR, Madhyapur

Under IRRI programme 50 ha demonstration has been taken up in Reamal Block. Head to head trial of 2 ha has also been taken up during this kharif.

Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Deogarh

Senior Scientist & Head briefed the activities of KVK like 6 nos. of farmers and farm women training has been conducted under Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline during this month. Doubling Farmers' Income by Technological Interventions of KVK is going on. In cluster demonstration of pulses (Pigeonpea) in total 20 ha area in villages like Kadopada, Majhipalli and Bangalimunda and the crop is in vegetative stage. In cluster demonstration of oil seed (Sesamum) seed sowing in progress in total 20 ha area in the villages like Prabhasuni & Kadopada. Action plan for the month of October 2017 proposed as 6 nos. farmers and farm women training of Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline will be conducted. OFT and FLD programmes are going on as per action plan.

The Chairman thanked all the members & urged cooperation from all line departments for benefit of farming community of the district.
